Signage Basics

California Vehicle Code
Sec. 22658(a)(1)

Allows vehicles to be **towed** from private property if it is **properly posted**.

Requirements:

1. Must prohibit public parking.
2. Indicate that vehicles will be removed at owner's expense.
3. Sign measurements must be no smaller than 17 inches by 22 inches, with letters measuring 1 inch in height.
4. Lakewood Sheriff's Station number must be included: 562-623-3500.
5. Name & telephone number of the towing company that is a party to a written general towing authorization agreement with the owner of the property.
6. Signs must be posted at each vehicle entrance and readily visible upon entering the property.
7. It's highly recommended when ordering signs to pay a little extra to get the graffiti coating film to protect and extend the life of your signs.



Additional Considerations

It is recommended that you also include other common nuisance violations in your signs such as the following:

1. **Trespassing Prohibited Penal Code 602**
2. **Public Drunkenness Paramount Municipal Ordinance (P.M.O.) Section 3-1**

Appearance

It is highly recommended that you maintain your property by doing the following:

1. Repair any damages to building exteriors such as paint, windows, doors, roofs, & fences.
2. Keep the property looking clean. If you don't, then you'll give the impression to others that it's ok to litter on your property. Provide trash cans so customers may dispose of their trash.

Appearance Continued

3. Immediately have any graffiti removed from your property.
4. Replace any damaged or vandalized signs.
5. Have appropriate lighting throughout your property. This will allow law enforcement to better see if anyone is on your property at night.
6. Cameras should be placed at major entrances to buildings & parking lots where they may record vehicle descriptions.
