

Article VII. Bicycle Routes.

Sec. 29-34. Posting and designating lanes.

- (a) Pursuant to the provisions of section 21207 of the California Vehicle Code, the city council hereby designates the director of public works as the director and coordinator of the city to designate those areas of the city as the city bicycle route as set forth in the adopted general plan
- (b) The director of public works is hereby authorized to erect or place signs and markings along and upon any street right-of-way in the general plan bicycle route of the city as may be directed by the city council from time to time, designating the existence of such bicycle lane and routes as may be necessary to regulate the operation and use of vehicles and bicycles with respect to the bicycle route.
- (c) When the bicycle route has been established and designated as indicated by signs or markings, no person shall drive or park any vehicle or bicycle contrary to such signs or markings. (Ord. No. 349)
